



Welcome to the second running of the Malton Motor Club Car Trial. The event is designed to be a relaxed event that is easily accessible to a wide variety of competitors in standard cars without risking damage as the course is run entirely on grass. Competitors are able to share cars if they desire and will be given sufficient time to allow both drivers to complete the full course. Any potential entrants who have questions about format or car eligibility are encouraged to contact the organisers as detailed below.

1. Malton Motor Club Limited will organise a Clubmans Permit car trial at: - Long Plain Farm, Sutton Bank Map Ref 100 / 521826 on Sunday 4th September 2016.
2. The meeting will be held under the General Regulations of the Motor Sports Association Limited (incorporating the provisions of the International Sporting Code of the FIA) and these Supplementary Regulations.
3. MSA Permit number TBC has been issued.
4. The event is open to: All fully elected members of the organising club who have attained the age of 14 years. (Day membership will be available on the day at a cost of £2.00 per person) All competitors must produce a valid club membership card. Entries are subject to the provisions of T4.1.3 for competitors who are age 14, 15 or 16 years (or 17 & over without a full RTA License. Front seat passengers must be at least 12 and comply with T4.1.7 if necessary.
5. The programme of the event will be: Scrutineering will start at 1030 hrs, The first car will start at 1200 hrs. Any competitor not signed on by 1200 hrs may be excluded. The event will finish at approximately 1600 hrs with results declared provisional.
6. The event will consist of three classes:
Class 1 - Front engined, front wheel drive cars.
Class 2 - Front engined, rear wheel drive cars.
Class 3 - Rear engined, rear wheel drive cars.

The minimum for each class is 3 entries. If less than 3 are received for any one class the organisers reserve the right to amalgamate classes.

7. The entry list opens on publication of these Regulations and closes finally on 3rd September 2016. Entries may be accepted on the day of the event at the discretion of the organisers. The entry fee is £20.00 per driver. All entries must be made on the official entry form and accompanied by the appropriate fee. 8. The maximum entry for the event is 30. The minimum is 12. The minimum for each class is 3. Should the minimum figure not be reached, the organisers reserve the right to cancel the event.

9. Other Officials are: Clerk of the Course: Gareth Frank, Deputy Clerk of the Course: Nick Skaife, Scrutineer: TBC, Secretary of the Meeting: Carol Gill, Club Steward TBC.

10. Provisional results will be published as soon as possible following the event. Any protests must be lodged in accordance with C5.1 to 5.7.

11. a) There will be at least 6 sections on private land. b) The entry may be split into groups starting at different hills. c) At least 2 runs (subject to weather conditions) d) Practising will not be allowed. e) Competitors will be identified by scorecards, which will be provided.

12. As the event takes place entirely upon private land, vehicles need not be registered or taxed. Some markers may be less than 1m in height. Entries will be accepted in order of receipt by the secretary of the meeting.

13. The event is open to production cars only, the definition of which is at the discretion of the organisers. Cars fitted with limited slip differentials are not permitted. Any cars fitted with an electronic traction control system must either disconnect it or will be imposed with a penalty of 1 mark per section. Road pattern tyres only are permitted, anything bearing marking such as "for competition use" or "M&S" are not allowed. The final decision on tyre eligibility will lie with the scrutineer. The minimum tyre pressure for all classes is 20psi, this may be checked during the event. Passengers must remain seated within the vehicle at all times.

14. The organisers reserve the right to cancel the event at very short notice on the ground of inclement weather. In the event of cancellation, the organisers will endeavour to contact all those entered as well as posting a notice on the Malton Motor Club website (maltonmc.co.uk) and facebook page.
