Spectator Information

Entrance Fee - £10 per car

Malton Motor Club are pleased to be running the Malton Forest Rally on Sunday 6th November 2016. The rally will be based within the Dalby Forest Complex at Adderstone Field.

Entries to the event promise the largest field of competitors seen in many a year. Local teams will be trading gravel with some of this countries top drivers.

The format of the day will be focus around three special stages

Special Stage	1 st Run	2 nd Run
Staindale	09:40 – 11:30	12:20 – 14:00
Birch Hall	10:00 – 12:00	12:45 – 14:30
Blakey Rigg	10:30 – 12:30	13:10 – 15:00

After Special Stage Blakey Rigg, competitors will return to Adderstone Field for a lunch stop and service.

Please note; sometimes during the running of the event, timings are subject to change. Please speak to the marshals in your area who will keep you advised of the latest information.

Staindale:

From Pickering or Thornton le Dale

Follow the signs for Dalby Forest and enter via the toll booth (841851), you will not need to pay the forest entrance fee, only the £10 per car spectator charge.

Follow the forest drive past the visitor centre and Staindale Lake.

Pass Adderstone Field service area and follow the green spectator arrows to enter the mid point of the stage (903906).

Please note the final approach to the stage will require you to travel on a gravel road for approximately 0.6 miles.

From Scarborough

In East Ayton take the turning opposite the Fish and Chip shop sign post "Forge Valley" (989849).

Follow this road to Hackness and at the T Junction (967900) turn left and follow the sign for Dalby Forest Drive.

Follow this road passing the Moorcock Inn then turn left to enter the forest drive at (915922) sign posted "Forest Drive Low Dalby". Please note the straight on spectator arrows will take you to the Blakey Rigg Stage.

Follow the green spectator arrows to enter the mid point of the stage (903906).

Please note the final approach to the stage will require you to travel on a gravel road for approximately 0.6 miles.

Blakey Rigg:

From Pickering or Thornton le Dale

Follow the signs for Dalby Forest and enter via the toll booth (841851), you will not need to pay the forest entrance fee, only the £10 per car spectator charge.

Follow the forest drive past the visitor centre and Staindale Lake.

Pass Adderstone Field service area and continue along the Forest Drive ignoring the left turn spectator arrows (903906) that are for Staindale.

Continue along the forest drive until you pass a telephone box (914921) then turn left and follow the spectator arrows to the mid point of the stage.

Please note the final approach to the stage will require you to travel on a gravel road for approximately 1.8 miles.

From Scarborough

In East Ayton take the turning opposite the Fish and Chip shop sign post "Forge Valley" (989849).

Follow this road to Hackness and at the T Junction (967900) turn left and follow the sign for Dalby Forest Drive.

Follow this road passing the Moorcock Inn then go straight on at the green spectator arrows where the road is signposted "Forest Drive Low Dalby" if turning left (915922).

Follow the spectator arrows to the mid point of the stage.

Please note the final approach to the stage will require you to travel on a gravel road for approximately 1.8 miles.

Due to difficult access, a lack of parking space and limited safe vantage points there is no spectator access to the Birch Hall stage. Anyone attempting to enter the stage will be turned away. Anyone choosing to enter this stage may put it in jeopardy if it is not safe to run. For the benefit of everyone involved with the rally and to secure the future of the event please go to the designated spectator area's.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

What we do ask is that you enjoy yourselves and keep yourselves safe. Please comply with requests from Officials and Marshals – they are there to ensure the safe running of the event.

On the competitive sections, rally cars travel very quickly and we have designated spectator areas to ensure you get a good view in as safe an environment as possible. Remember though – MOTORSPORT IS DANGEROUS AND YOU ARE PRESENT AT YOUR OWN RISK.

Green tape will guide you to the designated area. Hazard tape is there to define the limit of the spectator area. PLEASE DO NOT ATTEMPT TO CROSS THE TAPE

Spectator Safety

Don't:

- Stand on the track
- Stand below the level of the track
- Stand in front of arrows or signs
- Stand in Prohibited Areas
- Stand or sit on or near log piles, walls or fences
- Sit close to the edge of the track
- Block escape routes
- Be distracted
- Play games with your safety or that of the drivers
- Remove Stage signs or arrows
- Be the one to stop the Stage

Always:

- Expect the unexpected
- Listen for approaching cars
- Remain alert
- Leave yourself room to move quickly
- Try to keep behind something solid
- Keep children under supervision
- Keep dogs on a lead
- Do as the Marshals ask
- Help the Marshals to run a safe Stage

Be Sure That:

- The unexpected can happen
- If you ignore Marshals instructions the stage will be stopped
