1. Access to Scrutineering, Noise, Documentation & Trailer Parking

SATURDAY 3rd NOVEMBER

Noise Test & Scrutiny 13:00hrs - 17:00hrs Thornton le Dale

Documentation 13:00hrs - 17:15hrs Thornton le Dale

Noise Test, Scrutineering & Documentation will all be located at the Thornton le Dale Car Park (MR: 101 / 835829, YO18 7RR) on Saturday.

Please approach from the South via Low Marishes. There will be arrows directing vehicles from the A169 (MR: 100 / 807779).

Trailer unloading is to take place at The Golden Square, Low Marishes, Malton, YO17 6RH (MR: 101 / 809768).

Overnight trailer parking is permitted at Adderstone in Dalby, and this should be accessed via Ebberston, travelling North towards Givendale Head Farm (MR 101 / 839 891). Please park as directed and note that no trailers will be permitted into the Adderstone Field Service Area. Overnight trailer parking may not be secure, so please make sure you are able to secure your own trailer.

NO TRAILERS OR SERVICE VEHICLES WILL BE PERMITTED INTO THE THORNTON LE DALE CAR PARK FOR ANY REASON.

SUNDAY 4th NOVEMBER

Noise Test, Scrutineering & Documentation on Sunday will be located in the Adderstone Service Park. If you have booked Sunday Scrutiny, you will be given a time to attend, please make sure you adhere to this.

Please note that Documentation will close at Adderstone Field at 07:30hrs, to allow you time to attend the drivers briefing in Thornton Le Dale.

Access to Adderstone on Sunday is via Ebberston, travelling North towards Givendale Head Farm (MR 101 / 839 891). Please park as directed and note that no trailers will be permitted into the Adderstone Field Service Area.

2. Sunday Procedure

On Sunday you may take rally cars directly to the Thornton Le Dale Car Park. **ALL VEHICLES** going into Adderstone Field should go via Ebberston and Givendale Head Farm (MR 101 / 839 891). The route will be arrowed.

Exiting Adderstone, to attend the Drivers Briefing and MTC1, you need to travel down the Forest Drive - NOT THE WORKSHOP ROAD - This will be arrowed.

Please park as directed on Sunday morning in Thornton Le Dale and please keep noise to a minimum.

3. General Information for Scrutineering, Noise & Documentation

Process cards and numbers will be distributed at noise test, please make sure all numbers are affixed prior to entering the Scrutineering bays.

If you are using an in-car camera please ensure it is fitted prior to scrutineering and you have a completed in car camera form - available from the website or Noise Test.

MTC1 is located at Thornton le Dale car park. Prior to your start time please park in number order as directed by the marshals.

4. Adderstone Field Service Area

Access to the Service Area will be available from 1pm on Saturday. Trailers must be left in the trailer park before entering the service area. **No trailers are allowed in the**

service area. Parking within the service area will be strictly limited to one service vehicle per competing car. Please park as directed by the marshal when you arrive in the service area to ensure there is enough space for all crews. If your service vehicle is **over 7.5m** please notify the organisers via email entries@maltonmc.co.uk before Friday 2nd November so we can ensure there is enough space for all vehicles.

The service area will be open to competitors from 06:00hrs on Sunday 4th November. The service area is compacted stone, so boards may be required for jacks and/or axle stands. You must also use a groundsheet or tarpaulin, under pain of exclusion. Overnight parking is permitted at the Service Area on Saturday night for rally cars and service vans, however the area will not be classed as 'secure', so all vehicles are left at your own risk. Camping is also permitted, in the adjacent field - no caravans or motorhome's will be permitted in the service park unless they are your only service vehicle.

5. Auxiliary Service

Auxiliary service for those that have purchased an extra pass is between SS1 & SS2 then SS4 & SS5. There will be two-way rally traffic for a large portion of the route to the Auxiliary Service Area so please remind all support crews to be courteous to other road users and allow sufficient time to reach the Auxiliary Service Area without the need to speed. Any Auxiliary Support Crew deemed to be found driving in a manner likely to bring the sport into disrepute faces the following penalties for their associated competing crew:

1st Offence - £100 fine

2nd Offence - Exclusion

6. Forest Drive

There will be strict speed restrictions on Dalby Forest Drive throughout the weekend - this is so we can preserve the venue for future use. Speed guns may be in operation and those caught speeding will be made to pay an on-the-spot fine of £50, a second occurrence will mean exclusion without argument. Anyone proven to be connected to a competing car may also cause that car to be excluded - so please pass this message on. Please also avoid driving onto any grass verges whilst traversing the Forest Drive.

7. Logging Report & Start List

A logging report will be made on Friday and will be distributed at documentation as well as being displayed on the website. A start list will be issued at the pre-start holding and will be on display in the Rally HQ and the website by 07.00hrs on Sunday morning - the start list will show any late entries and your due start time. Car 101 is due to start at 08:31hrs.

8. Rally HQ

Rally HQ will be situated at Thornton le Dale car park until 1800hrs on Saturday 3rd November. After this time Rally HQ will be located within Adderstone Field. The contact number for Rally HQ is 07800 830 309 or 07711 094 309.

Rally results will be based Adderstone Field, so there will be up-to-date results throughout the day. Results will also be updated onto www.rallies.info and the club website www.maltonforestrally.co.uk at the end of the event.

9. Competitor Briefing

A short competitor briefing will be held on Sunday 4th November at 08:00HRS in Thornton le Dale, at least one competing member of each crew must attend. Time cards will be issues at the end of the Competitor briefing.

10. Official Notice Board & Competitor Liaison Officer

The Official Notice Board will be situated in the Rally HQ. A named Judge of Fact List will appear on the official Notice board.

The CLO for the event is Heidi Woodcock 07790 970 677. Heidi will be at Scrutineering on Saturday and around the service in and out controls on Sunday.

11. RalliTrak Radio

We will be using RalliTrak Radio for the event - you will be issued with a radio at Scrutiny. Please make sure you are happy with how to use the radio and the procedure, if you are unsure ask at the time or come to us in Rally HQ. You are not penalised for using the radio, it is there to help you keep in touch with us and inform us of what is happening to you on the stages, if you are out, broken down or changing a puncture, please tell us! Keep the Rally Moving - Use Your Radio!

12. Miscellaneous

The route passes Middleton petrol station (Esso) on 4 occasions. BP Petrol is also available just off route in Pickering (MR: 100/799835)

Hot and cold food and drink will be available at Thornton le Dale on Saturday afternoon and Sunday morning and in the service area on Sunday, courtesy of Two Jays Catering.

A measured mile is set out from Thornton le Dale heading South towards Marishes.

LITTER - there will be rubbish collection points in the service area, but please take home as much rubbish as you can, and that includes all fuel cans and car parts.
