Spectator Information

Spectators - £10 per car all day.

SS1/SS4 - Cropton

SS1 - 1st Car due - 08:56

SS4 - 1st Car due - 12:50

SS1/SS4 - Junction 7

MR: SE751908

Postcode: YO18 8EP

From Pickering head east along the A170 towards Kirkbymoorside and turn left towards Wrelton. Continue through Wrelton to the village of Cropton. In Cropton follow the road round to the left and down Cropton Bank for approximately 1.5 miles. The entrance to the forest is on the right hand side, signposted 'Spiers House Caravan and Camping.' The spectator point will be arrowed from here.

SS1/SS4 - Junction 12

Postcode: YO18 8HS

From Pickering head north towards Newton-on-Rawcliffe for 4 miles and continue through the village, towards Stape. Keep right at the top of Stape bank and follow the road down the other side. Continue through Stape and on the way down the hill, the entrance to the Forest is on the left hand side at Middle Head Road. The Spectator Area will be arrowed from here.

Junction 2 / Junction 4 & 5

The above spectator points are accessed from the same piece of road with 2 entrances to forest, roughly 500m apart.

From Pickering head north towards Newton-on-Rawcliffe for 4 miles and continue through the village, towards Stape. Keep right at the top of Stape bank and follow the road down the other side. Continue through Stape, down the hill, following the road round to left at the bottom. Continue up the hill, passing and entrance to the forest on the right. The road will wind down through a ford and then up onto the moor, passing over a cattle grid. Follow this for roughly 1 mile and the entrance to the forest is on the right hand side. The Spectator Area will be arrowed from here.

- Always keep your own safety in mind
- Park in a safe place
- Follow Marshalls instructions
- Observe and obey events signs
- Stay within Spectator Areas
- Red and white tape - 'No Go Area'
- Do not enter 'PROHIBITED AREAS'
- Keep off the track
- Listen to official announcements
- Expect the unexpected
- Have fun but keep safe!
- Black and yellow tape - 'Spectator Area'
